Pertinent to the INPS Scholarship topics. The research project may be written in Italian or in English language and it must contain: applicant's name and surname; **RESEARCH PROJECT** • title of the research project • curriculum applicant is running for (please, check just one of the four curricula); • summary and key words max 500 characters, spaces included (identification of the research question, main expected results, originality of the research); The extended version of project description must have a length of maximum 12.000 characters, min 5.000 (spaces included) and should include: organization of the scientific problem and connected questions, with reference to the state-of-the-art; objectives and expected results; methodology and activities (with an indication of the tools that you deem necessary for the performance, already owned or to be acquired); cultural and social interest and expected scientific impact on the scientific community; list of references.
